Application Manual Wheel Headlight Leather Metal Trim * Do not handle until all usage and precautions of this manual have been read and understood.



For Wheels —— How to use

- 1. Wash off all the dirt and contaminants from the aluminum wheels before application.
- 2.Use an air blowerer to remove moisture completely. It causes coating to turn cloudy if moisture remains.
- 3.Use an application sponge to take an appropriate amount of liquid and apply it evenly to the wheel.
- 4. Spread it while wiping it up with a dry cloth immediately after application.
- 5. Wait for at least 5 minutes if you want to apply another layer. Repeat above steps several times to get a stronger layer.



For Headlights — How to use

- 1.Check the condition of headlights and remove the deteriorated hard coat layer by polishing.
- 2.Degrease the headlight surfaces. We recommend using hot water but not solvent, since solvent might cause cracks or white turbidity on headlights.
- 3.Use an air blower to remove moisture completely before application.
- 4.Apply one headlight at a time. Do not try to apply two headlights at the same time. Use an application sponge to take an appropriate amount of liquid and apply it evenly to the headlight.
- 5. Wipe it off with a dry cloth immediately after application.
- 6. If you expect a thicker coating layer, repeat Step 4 and Step 5.



For Leather — How to use

- 1.Remove all the dirt from leather surface with a special leather cleaner before application.
- 2.Dry the leather thoroughly and make sure no cleaner ingredients or moisture remain.
- 3.Use an application sponge to take an appropriate amount of liquid and apply it lightly and evenly to the leather surface.
- 4. Wipe it off with a dry cloth immediately after application.
- *Do not try to apply to a large area on leather seat at one time. Apply to each area separately, such as head rest, backrest, seating and armrest.



For Metal Trim — How to use

- 1.Clean the metal trim before application. Polish it if necessary. (Recommended item: METAL AID Chrome One Step Finish)
- 2.Use an air blower to remove moisture completely and then degrease the surface before application. If coating agent contacts with water, it might cause white turbidity.
- 3.Use masking tape to keep coating from adhering to other parts except metal trim parts.
- 4.Use an application sponge to take a small amount of liquid.
- 5. Apply it lightly and evenly to the metal trim surface.
- 6. Wipe it off with a dry cloth immediately after application.
- 7.If you expect a thicker coating layer, repeat Step 4, 5 and 6.
